GIFT MATCHING PROGRAM: THE COORDINATORS

The coordinators are the driving force behind the Gift Matching Program. They are the ones who take on the job of organizing a group of colleagues willing to become involved in a specific solidarity project.

The coordinators are also charged with the task of keeping their donor colleagues up to date with the progress of the initiative through telephone calls, in-person meetings or sometimes through relevant internet websites and blogs. This activity, that can last for some years, is a marker of a personal involvement which reflects the coordinators' awareness of the social importance of the role they have undertaken, both as ordinary citizens as well as employees of an organization that pays particular attention to social responsibility.

Inside this publication, you will find reports by foreign colleagues as well as an interview with Michele Betetto. To celebrate the tenth anniversary of the Gift Matching Program of UniCredit Foundation, Betetto was given an award in recognition of his role as coordinator of 84 supporters who raised more funds than any other group in Italy.

MICHELE BETTETTO: A STANDING OVATION COORDINATOR

Entitled “The Painful No”, this was the project that attracted the most donations within the Gift Matching Program in Italy in 2012. The funds raised totalled EUR 22,223 from 84 donations. The beneficiary of this significant sum was the association named “The Castle of Smiles” whose founder and president is Michele Betteto, an employee in the Fraud Prevention & Management Service of Unicredit Business Integrated Solutions in Verona. Voluntary work is a way of life for Michele: “My parents taught me to do it,” he says, “and I continued to help others when I had my own family. For many years we hosted children from Chernobyl. A group of parents and I decided to take up the challenge firsthand and we founded “The Castle of Smiles” association.”.

Can you describe the project?

The association brings seriously ill children to ITALY from their home countries where they would be unable to receive adequate care. We participated in the Gift Matching Program with “The Painful No” project in order to raise more funds to help more children. The association’s name was chosen to encourage colleagues to donate to our cause so that we would not be obliged to say no to parents seeking our help for their ill children. To deny a child the medical care he needs is painful not only

for the parents but also for us who work for the association.

What countries do you operate in?

Mostly Kosovo. The war there in 1999 was fought using bullets and bombs containing depleted uranium and 14 years later, these weapons are still indirectly causing victims among the children born in this contaminated territory. They are born with tumours, leukemia and malformations of the heart.

What are the diseases you can offer help with?

Cases of oncohaematology are out of reach for us because of the elevated costs involved and the unpredictability in the duration of the treatment. However, we can deal with diseases of the heart. Surgery costs range from 15,000 to 30,000 euros and we can count on the availability of the staff in the heart surgery ward of the hospital in Verona. We are in a race against time because often with pathologies of the heart, the newborn can survive only a few days so it is necessary to take action immediately.

This project won because of the overwhelming response of Unicredit employees. How did you manage to convince so many of your colleagues?

«Our goal is to bring sick children in Italy who can not be cared for in their country of origin»

I have been working at the bank for 19 years and have had occasion to meet many people. This made it easier and since I have kept track of my contacts, I have a mailing list of 500 colleagues. I keep in touch with them throughout the year, encouraging them to donate and to read our website where the stories of children we have sponsored for operations and treatment are published. I’m not the only Unicredit employee involved in the association – there are 4 other colleagues in the Verona area.

What were the three reasons that made so many choose “The Painful No” project?

My colleagues have known me personally for many years and the association is not new to those who were invited to take part in the 2012 GMP. Moreover, many colleagues can come and visit the association directly, at least those who live in Verona. I like to invite them to come with me to the hospital where the children from abroad are being cared for. Holding one of these little patients in your arms arouses more empathy than the most beautifully written e-mail ever could.

GIFT MATCHING PROGRAM: THE PROJECT FICHES

The Gift Matching Program is, after this tenth edition, the Unicredit's largest solidarity project and one of the most important European philanthropic initiatives in terms of numbers of participants.

UniCredit Foundation supports the charities their employees are involved in and has succeeded in creating a unique corporate culture that includes also solidarity, sharing and participation in the third sector.

The Gift Matching Program reflects values that the employees believe in and for this reason acts to reinforce motivation and commitment in each one of them. The employees feel proud to be part of the Group and become ambassadors for the Group.

The employees become active partners in their communities and thanks to the Gift Matching Program, they not only help non-profit organizations, but also actively promote the culture of solidarity and sustainability.

PROJECTS IN 2012 COUNTRY BY COUNTRY

AUSTRIA - Accomodation for refugees - SOS Children's Village Salzburg

Since 2001 the house of Sos Children's village Salzburg has been offering unaccompanied children refugees a safe home. Here teenagers with traumatic experiences have the chance to receive the required primary care, social and educational medical care, legal assistance and psychological support. The building was 35 years old and in need of renovation. Now the house has turned into a modern, bright and friendly building.

Participants: 53 **Donation:** 2.260 euros

AUSTRIA - Accomodation, medical help and boarding for refugees - House

Since its founding in 1995 more than 720 refugees and asylum seekers have found accommodation, meals, medical and psychosocial care thanks to the House project integration. The association is especially focused on the care of people coping with trauma or with a difficult family situation as single parents or minor refugees and women refugees.

AUSTRIA - Aid for blind and visually impaired people - The Austrian International Organization

The Austrian international organization is primarily engaged in the support for eye diseases and blind people in poor areas of the world and works, for example, with the World Health Organization.

Since its foundation in 1988, the association has provided outstanding scientific services in the Research Institute for Children with Cancer, which is highly regarded worldwide.

There are currently 50 children of all ages living with their supervisors and as in an extended family, everyone has some small key tasks to do.

WHAT TEACHES THE GROWTH OF GIFT MATCHING PROGRAM

UniCredit Foundation's Gift Matching Program has grown over the years, widening its borders to include the entire UniCredit universe to the point where it has become an important element in defining the identity of what is one of the most important European banking groups. It is this continental aspect that has added a more interesting and vital dimension to the Gift Matching Program.

This worldwide network of people involved in the same program should be seen as a contribution to the building of a shared vision that nowadays it would otherwise be difficult to create. Solidarity practised in a modern way to respond to the thousands of new needs of our times has in fact brought about the emergence of a cultural and historical outcome that in primis has guaranteed coexistence and progress (but not only) to our continent. An outcome that would be wrong to see as secondary to the large-scale trends of history because, on the contrary, it has always left a deep mark in history. One only has to look at how the first welfare institutions were established in Europe originating from a deep-seated moral belief that the production of wealth should, as much as possible, bring benefits to the community as a whole. In the present day, the fact that solidarity is engendered within a large financial institution such as

UniCredit revives that same dynamic of goodwill.

The Gift Matching Program launched in 2013 has now existed for ten years despite having gone through, for much of that time, one of the worst financial crisis the western world has ever had to face. This is another important element that must give rise to some reflection: it is not true that individuals faced with the difficulties of the financial crisis, react by turning inwards and put off acts of solidarity to better times.
